The Ames Family had a treasure of their own that we had to design around. An heirloom stained glass window was given to Mrs. Ames when a local school that the Ames family helped build was being torn down. A few of the family members received these rare windows, but Mrs. Ames knew she wanted to do something special with hers.

She came to us with the hope that we could incorporate the window into a monument. The "A" window became our focal point. It had to be re-glazed and lead work redone and then encased in glass to prevent some issues of vandalism.

The window is now a permanent part of the family history in the monument on their family lot. Our custom Roman style font used for the family name works beautifully with the Roman style letter in the window.
