He was a teacher in Weihai China at the time of his passing and his family wanted an Asian influence to be a part of the monument. We had come up with a number of rough renderings for the family to look at, each with a distinct Asian feel in the design. They felt that the Asian theme was probably too prevalent in the rough concepts since he was not Asian himself. After some thought, we decided to add his portrait into the design and incorporate a somewhat yin and yang feel to the pillow. This was achieved by the rock pitching and shape of the pillow itself. We were asked to incorporate a necklace he wore which we used as the spacer between the dates, as well we added the lyrics of his favorite Bob Marley song to the base.
