Cremation isn't always because the family wants to do the least expensive thing. Cremation is a life choice today and it is not always based on economics.

This cremation monument has room for 6 cremations. The front of the monument has three different family names engraved. (The family has requested that all the names not be shown on this entry). The other three sides incorporate the three family groups' inscriptions.

We needed to make this monument functional because it needs to be opened 4 more times. We incorporated a check cut on the top cap so that it would be easy for the opening and closings in the future. The family wanted something with a feeling of openness and something with more than just granite. We worked with the bronze company to see what type of bronze panels could be created into something unique. As soon as the daughters saw this pattern, they loved it. The two panels cast as one made a heart to represent the family love.

The clean simple lines were so pleasing to the sisters. They were very excited to know that something so elegant, sophisticated and stylish could be achieved in something that would last forever.

Cremation is our future and we all have to adapt and educate the public to cremation memorialization options.
